#### JOB RESPONSIBILITIES: :

- Observe and co-lead therapeutic activities for the Hope@Home™ Kids group
- Observe and co-lead therapeutic activities for the Hope@Home™ Teen group
- Create and implement therapeutic activities for children and families served
- Observe at least one adult-specific Hope@Home™ Group per week
- Lead the Saturday Storytime Group for preschool children who are facing the loss or death of a parent
- Complete assigned readings and weekly child life supervision with a Certified Child Life Specialist
- Partner with the Hope@Home™ Groups Manager and Coordinator to help develop group curriculum and resources

#### ELIGIBILITY:

- Must have reliable internet
- Proficient with technology (Google Docs, Zoom, etc.)
- Have at least a sophomore status or have completed/be in the second year of college or university in a related field with applicable coursework (non-affiliated students will also be considered)
- Have at least 50 hours of experience working with healthy children or adolescents
- Be committed to learning and advancing knowledge of child life in a non-traditional setting
